#### CREDIT COMMITTEE REPORT

The committee has met weekly to consider and act upon the loan applications throughout the year. In addition, members were counseled, assisted, advised and in some instances prevented from overextending their obligations. We have tried to be fair with all members and approve loan that would fit the members needs, governed by ability to repay.

The total number of loans granted in 1972 was 761, totaling the amount of \$686,001.29. During the 25 years of organization 10,196 loans have been made, a total of \$6,239,173.61.
